 - Fire and explosion
- Purpose and features of emergency plans

It is recommended that students should already have an underpinning knowledge of health and safety issues, and many will have gained another NEBOSH qualification. Candidates are assessed by a 90 minute multiple choice examination. A qualification parchment will be sent to students on successful completion.

The participants' number does not exceed the 15 individuals, to optimize interaction. Minimum standard of English required for candidates.

The standard of English required by candidates studying the NEBOSH HSE Certificate in Process Safety Management (PSM) must be such that they can both understand and articulate the concepts contained in the syllabus. It is important to stress that the onus is on accredited course providers to determine their candidates' standards of proficiency in English.
